Get creative and make a new Christmas tree decoration to go on your tree.

Spelling/Phonics

Every Thursday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Thursday. These spellings will be in line with the year I HFW list.

Remember to include a beginning, problem, solution and ending. Don't forget adjectives!

Complete by: 27.11.24 Science Task

Using the template, draw a picture to show how trees change in the different seasons.

Go for a short walk around your local area. When you get back, create/draw a map of your walk. Can you use map symbols?
