Year 1 – Spring 1

Challenge yourself to the **green** box activities. These do not have to be done, but if you want to push yourself, that would be super!

Reading

You must read at least 3 times a week at home. Each time ask an adult to write a comment on Go Read.

Complete by: 15.1.25 Writing Task

Write about what you did over the Christmas holidays. What did Santa bring you for Christmas? Can you include adjectives?

Art

Make a dinosaur mask or sock puppet and bring it into school to show to your friends.

Complete by: 22.1.25 Reading Task

Read the facts about dinosaurs together with a grown up and answer the questions.
(sheet provided)

DT

Research different species of dinosaurs – can you junk model your favourite dinosaur using materials you might find at home – you could always paint it too.

Science

Research and write about your favourite animals- which animal category are they part of? Where do they live? What do they eat? Label their body parts.

Research your favourite dinosaur and make a fact file all about it!

Spelling/Phonics

Every Thursday you will receive spellings to be learnt and practiced for the week.

Can you write a poem all about a dinosaur – you can perform this to your friends!

Complete by: 29.1.25 Writing Task

Write a set of instructions to make something. It could be instructions to make a craft. Remember to add a title, steps and picture!

Complete by: 5.2.25 Maths Task

Practice spelling numbers as words to 20...challenge yourself to write numbers as words beyond 20.

Create a dinosaur themed wordsearch! See if mummy or daddy can find all the words that you have hidden!

Complete by: 12.2.25 Topic

Make a poster or a leaflet all about Mary Anning or David Attenborough- who were/are they? What did they discover? Why are they important?

Create a **reading river** to show all the things you read in a day. Think about all the things you read. Not just books.

Number Facts

Practice counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 5s and 10's.
Extra challenge – start your timetables from a random number. e.g count in 2's starting at 10.
