Reading

Topic Task

We are going to be learning all about different modes of transport in the past and present. Find out a fact about a car or an aeroplane from the past and find out how it is the same or different now. Can you draw a picture of it?

Complete by 12/06/24

Challenge:

Do you have a kite you could take to the park and fly?
Don't worry if you don't have one, maybe you could make one using a bin bag and string?

Maths Task

Complete the doubling sheet at home with a grown up.
You can use pictures or objects to help you!

Complete by 19/06/24

Challenge:

Can you write a story about something fun you have done on a warm, summers day. This could include going to the beach, having a BBQ or going swimming.

Challenge:

Can you make a boat and put it in some water. Make a prediction, do you think it will float or sink? You could explore floating and sinking with other objects too!

Challenge:

Can you spot the odd and even numbers up to 20 on the coconuts?

Phonics

Practise learning all 100 high frequency words. Once you can read a word, learn how to spell it and see if you can write a sentence with some high frequency words in.

Challenge:

Can you make a summer collage? How is your summer collage different to your spring collage? What changes have you noticed between the two seasons?

Challenge:

Can you practice recalling doubles and halves up to 20
You could use objects to help you e.g. double 9 is, half of 18 is...

Understanding of the World Task:

Draw a picture of a beach. Write a sentence about it or label what you can see. For example, shells, seaweed, sand, rocks.

Complete by 26/06/24

Challenge:

Can you make a healthy summer smoothie or snack?
Choose some fruits and vegetables and see what flavours you can create.

Writing Task:

Draw a picture of your favourite memory from your time in Reception.
Write a sentence telling me all about it.

Complete by 03/07/24

Challenge:

Talk to your grown ups about trips to the seaside in the past. Was it different to how it is now? Do they have any photos or postcards to show you?
